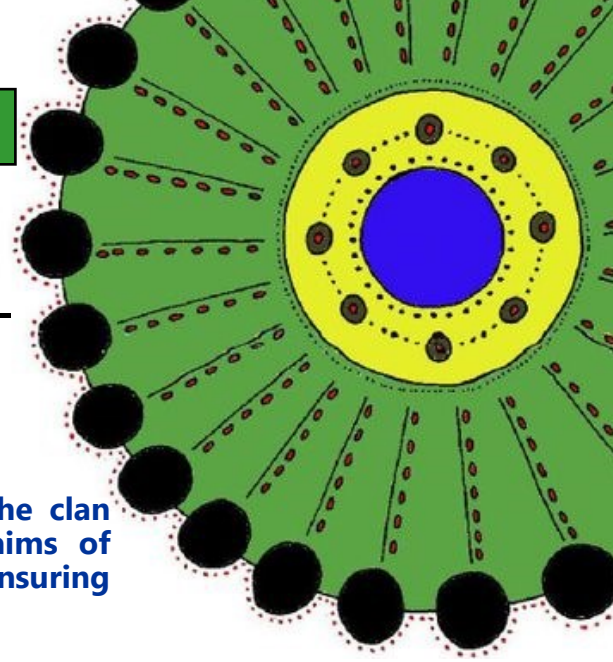

Self Care & Health Care Fun



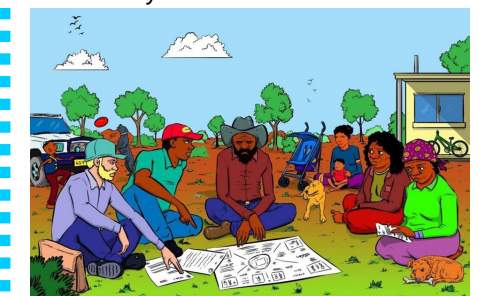
The Palumpa community have been coming together and having some fun with self care and health care.

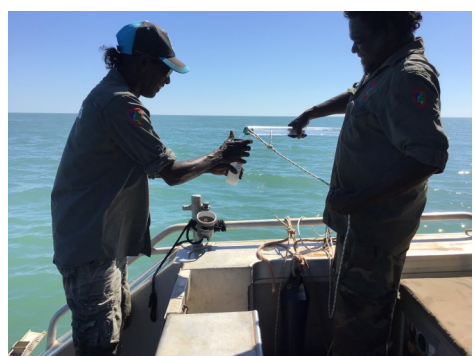
AIMS Ranger Training

AIMS and the Rangers are key partners in a collaborative project to monitor the health of sea country.



The marine biodiversity survey project, which began in 2020 gives the Thamarurr Rangers the opportunity to receive training in techniques to monitor their marine environment and uses a blend of western science and traditional ecological knowledge. It is hoped that monitoring will be continued into the future as part of a long-term program to help track changes and identify threats to Thamarurr sea country.
