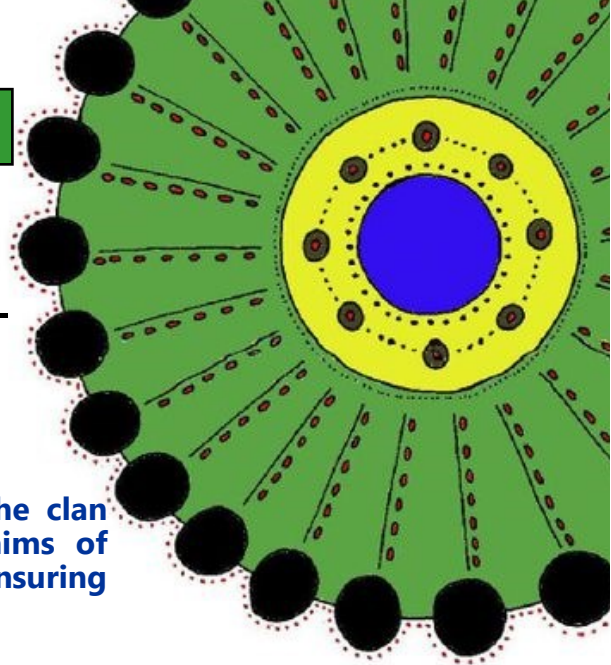

**MVR Services Now at Post Office**

The Post Office team are pleased to announce that the Wadeye Local Post office can assist with the following MVR services:

- Renew your NT driver licence and get a new photo taken if you need.
- Renew your NT vehicle registration for 1, 3, 6 or 12 months .
- Submit your roadworthy inspection if required.
- Update your contact details.
- Transfer your interstate licence to the NT
- Apply for a replacement driver licence card - You will need your licence number
- Sign up to receive SMS reminders.

If you don't have your renewal notice, you can still renew your registration or driver licence, you just need to show your ID.

If you have restricted conditions on your NT driver licence, you must visit your local MVR office

If you have an occupational authority (endorsement) that is also due for renewal, or an XA condition on your NT driver licence, you must visit your local MVR office
