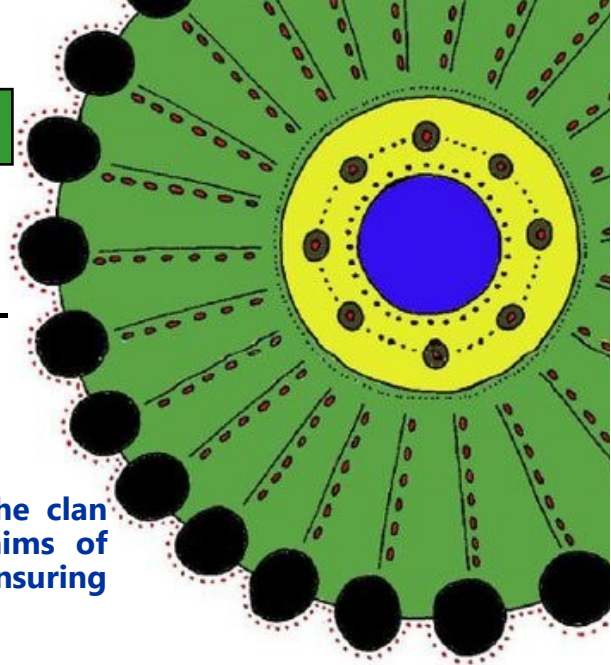

The Healthy Homes crew did Pest Control training this week and there were no shortage of takers when an invitation went out for people to volunteer their premises for the crew to do the practical training units.

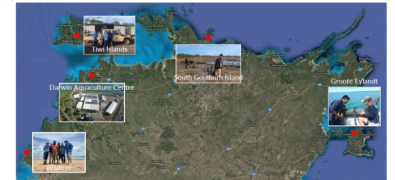


There was nowhere for critters to hide from these two fellas. The guys applying their Pest Management skills and showing they know how to fix pest problems. Great work!
