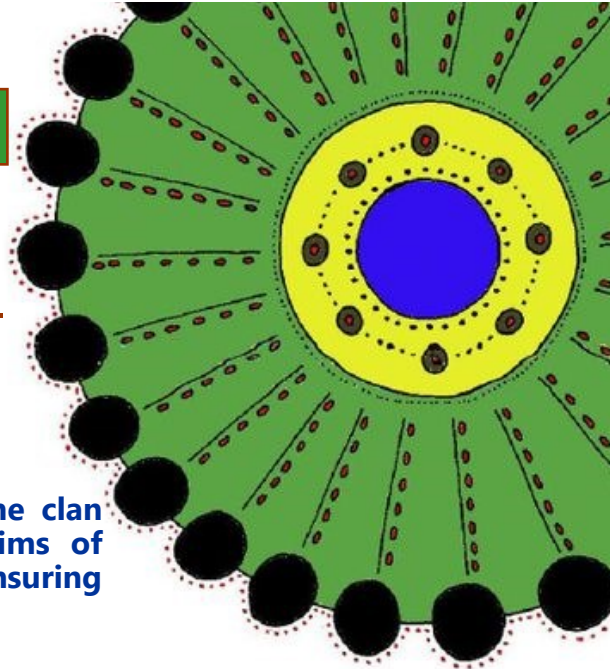

2023 Referendum on the Voice

The countdown to the Voice referendum starts, with only 8 days before Australia will decide on whether to recognise the First Peoples of Australia by establishing an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice.

Most of Australia will vote on Saturday the 14th of October, but remote community voting will start next week.

The Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) will start collecting votes in Wadeye and surrounds from Monday the 9th October (see table below).

The question that people will be asked is :

A Proposed Law: to alter the Constitution to recognise the First Peoples of Australia by establishing an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice. Do you approve this proposed alteration?

When you receive a ballot paper at the referendum, you should write 'Yes' if you agree with this proposed change to the Constitution, or you should write 'No' if you do not agree.

The Voice will be chosen by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people based on the wishes of local communities.

The Voice would make representations to the Parliament and the Executive Government on matters relating to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. For more information on the principals of the Voice [Click Here](#).
